

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT: CHURCH ORGANIST

Hope Lutheran Church is seeking a professional organist to accompany the church choir and congregation for the enrichment of the worship life of the church. The organist sets the mood and spirit of the service for the congregation. Organ and piano solos are provided when necessary. The church organist must work closely with the choir director, the worship and music committee, and the pastors.

This is an at-will, part-time position of approximately 6 hours per week, 52 weeks per year. The starting yearly salary is \$10,500.00 to \$11,500.00, commensurate to qualifications and experience.

Minimum Requirements include:

- Knowledge of organ and other keyboard literature, Christian hymnody, and liturgical, music
- Advanced organ and piano proficiency
- Bachelor's Degree in Music or comparable professional training and experience
- Experience as a church organist and accompanist preferred
- Ability to work collaboratively with the choir, soloists, and others involved in the church music program
