## Young Member Spotlight





Although the COVID-19 pandemic has drastically limited music programs in our communities, some organizations are making a remarkable effort to continue investing in young musicians. In the last several months, Grant Smith was privileged to participate in an organ competition and an organ festival.

Online competitions are difficult to manage, but the American Guild of Organists administered its Regional Competition for Young Organists professionally and fairly. The competition is structured so that AGO chapters across the country host local competitions, and winners of the chapter level competitions advance to the regional finals. The AGO strove to recreate live performances for the competition by requiring competitors to have their recordings proctored, which ensured that no competitors took multiple takes or edited their recordings. Repertoire for the competition totaled about fifty minutes and included a contemporary work for organ written by James Woodman titled "Sonata in Sea." Grant was pleased to receive first place in the Los Angeles chapter competition in April and second place in the West Regional competition in May.

The Oregon Bach Festival usually attracts thousands of concertgoers to world-class concerts in Eugene, but this year, the concerts were delivered online. But one aspect of the festival took place in-person this July: the Organ Institute. Grant was selected along with three other young organists to participate in a week of organ instruction from performing artist and Juilliard professor Paul Jacobs. Daily masterclass were held at local churches, organ builders came and spoke about the instruments and their construction, and a student recital took place on the final evening. Grant was so thankful for the opportunity to learn from such an accomplished organist.
